Additionally, Dynamic Health is taking the following steps in its office to prevent the spread of the virus.

## Patient Protection Measures Being Taken (updated 6/25/2020):

- Doctors and staff are utilizing face coverings per CDC guidelines and the NC mandate (updated)
- We have installed several cleaners developed by NASA that kill all pathogens in air and on surfaces. These pathogens include bacteria and, most importantly, viruses like the coronavirus and other stronger viruses.
- Patients or staff that believe they (or any family members) may have any of the symptoms of the coronavirus are being instructed to stay home and instead call their doctor for further instructions on testing.
- Patient appointments are being spread out throughout the day so as to minimize the number of patients in the waiting area at any one time
- Hand sanitizer stations are provided upon entering and exiting the building, as well as throughout the common areas and treatment rooms
- Seating in the patient waiting area is now spaced farther apart (social distancing)

- Therapies have been spaced out on the floor (social distancing)
- All staff have been trained in identifying the symptoms of the coronavirus and the immediate steps to take if they suspect someone may have the symptoms
- The office is being cleaned and sanitized throughout the day with increased emphasis on disinfecting all frequently touched surfaces continuously
- Doctors and staff are sanitizing their hands before and after they touch any patient
- All staff have been retrained in proper hand washing and sanitizing practices to minimize the spread of germs
